

#### Are you Shepherding?

In the Gospel, Jesus and his disciples plan for some much needed R&R. They get to their destination only to be overwhelmed with more people. Jesus is moved with compassion to see so many sheep without a shepherd. There are so many sheep, really so many lost sheep in this world that it is overwhelming. It seems daunting. We need shepherds. We need lots of them. I know our knee-jerk reaction is that we need more priests, true. However, we cannot solely rely on priests to fix our shepherding problem. Vatican II was a call for a greater involvement of the laity in shepherding our church. Sadly it seems like once again there is movement in the church to revert back to laying the responsibility solely on the priests, a movement back to a pre-Vatican II church. Obviously this isn't going to work. This is going to lead to smaller churches. Where is the shepherding for the lost?

If you are listening or reading this message, the responsibility falls on all of us to shepherd the lost sheep in our world. How do we shepherd? First of all, many people in the church live on the periphery. They live with one foot in and one foot out of the church. We have forgotten our calling. We are to become Christ. It's not enough to just make a part of our life spiritual, to compartmentalize our spirituality. We are called to make our whole life spiritual. It is when we make our whole life spiritual that we can be a witness to others. What usually holds us back is that there is some part of our life that is not jiving with the Gospel. In some ways this is normal. This is the time to talk to a spiritual director like me or others that are listed on our website. This can take us to the next level. This helps us to integrate our spiritual life as opposed to the disintegration we feel. What a great witness to others to have a spiritual director. It is then that we can shepherd other people to be spiritual.

Another way we can shepherd people is to lead them to the program of Discovering Christ. We will be starting it again at the end of August and signups will be soon. Discovering Christ is like a beginner's retreat. We meet once a week on Thursdays for 7 weeks. There is a free dinner and baby-sitting followed by a video presentation and then discussion. In the discussion time people experience what a small faith community is all about. We need small faith communities to support us in our spiritual lives. Encouraging people to do Discovering Christ is a great way to shepherd people. I invite all people to do it.

There are many other ways to shepherd people. One way is to develop deeper relationships with others. When you do that you can eventually talk about your spiritual life. Another way to shepherd is inviting people to church. What other ways may you shepherd?







St. Angela of Foligno (c. 1248–1309), sometimes called the "Teacher of Theologians," Angela's first life as a wife and mother gave her unique insights.
